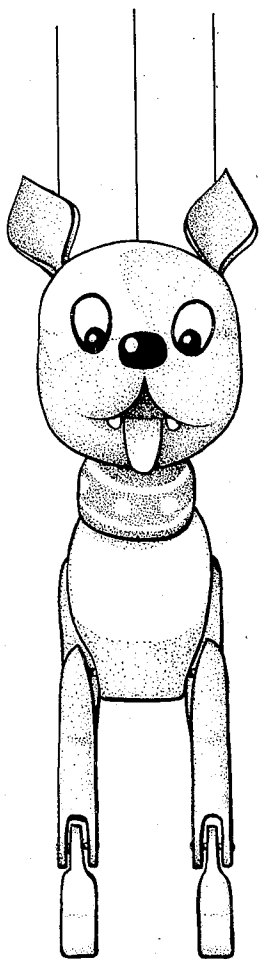

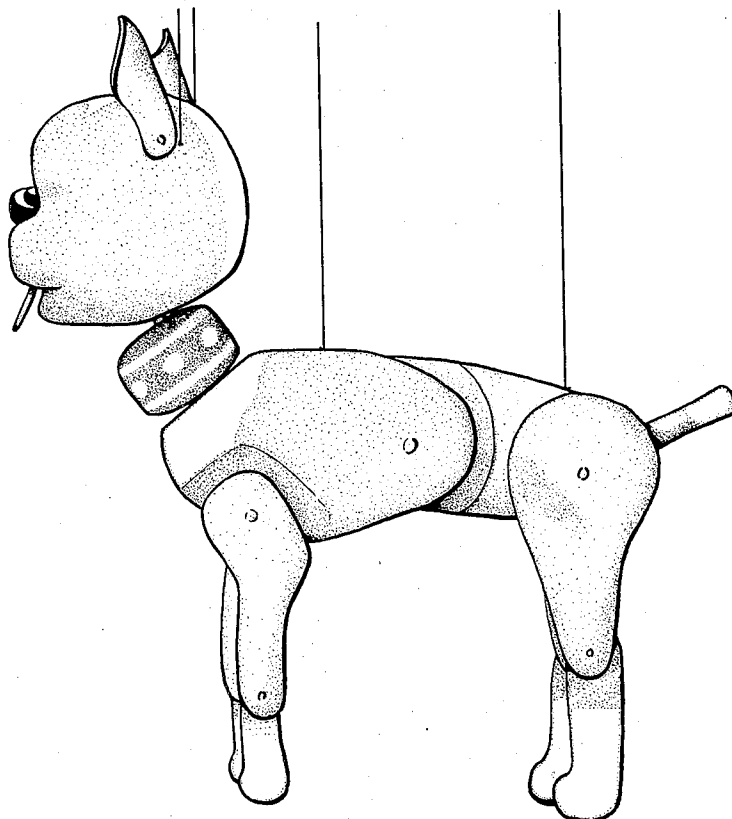

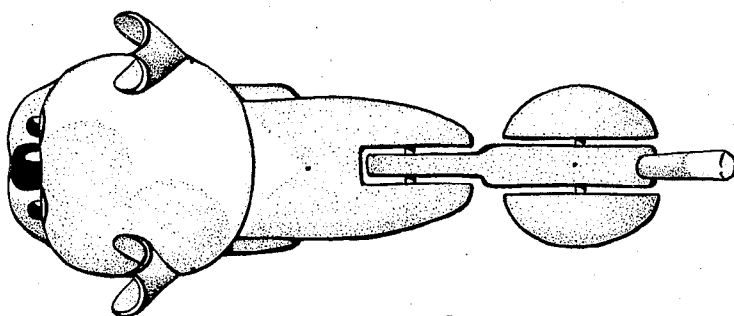

DESIGN FOR A PUPPET ANIMAL FIGURE

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Robert K. Ostrander, a citizen of the United States, residing at South Orange, county of Essex and State of New Jersey, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Puppet Animal Figure, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof, wherein:

Figure 1 is a side elevational view of a puppet animal figure showing my new design;

Figure 2 is a front elevational view of the puppet animal figure of Figure 1; and

Figure 3 is a plan view of the puppet animal figure of Figure 1.
