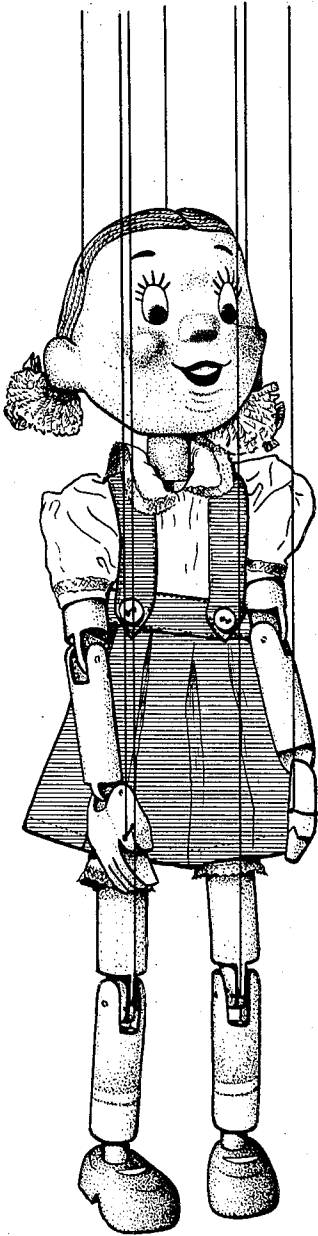

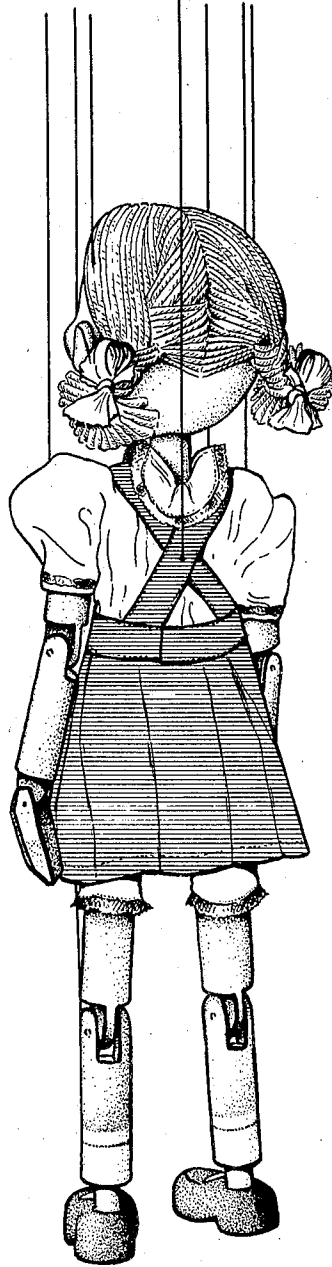

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Robert K. Ostrander, a citizen of the United States, residing at South Orange, county of Essex, and State of New Jersey, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Puppet Doll, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof, wherein:

Fig. 1 is a front perspective view of a puppet doll, showing my new design; and

Fig. 2 is rear perspective view thereof.
