

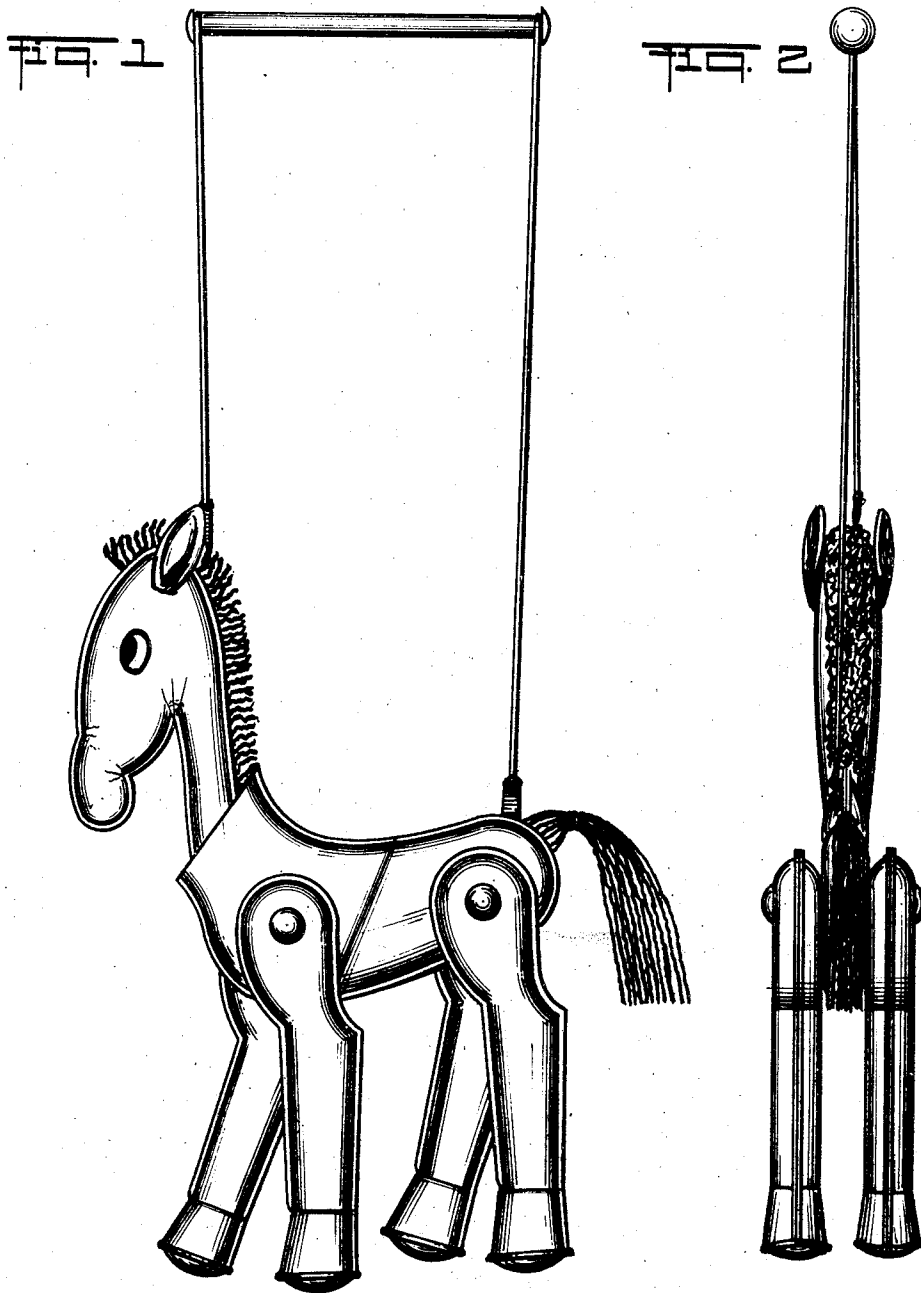

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Martin Shrier, a citizen of Poland, residing at Forest Hills, in the county of Queens, city and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Stuffed Puppet Toy Animal, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

Fig. 1 is a side elevational view of a stuffed puppet toy animal, showing my new design;

Fig. 2 is a rear elevational view thereof.
